Kids'N'Church

Children of all ages are always welcome in worship! Quiet books and pew pals (soft toys) are available in our **family room**, just outside the sanctuary, where you'll also find a cozy couch, big toy box, and a speaker that broadcasts the service. All bathrooms have **changing tables**. Our **Nursery** is available for infants & toddlers when volunteers are available. **Sunday School** (for children in older Pre-K through Grade 5) and **Youth Group** (grades 6-12) are both offered during our 10am worship service, typically on the 2nd & 4th Sundays. All children and youth remain in the sanctuary with their families to share **communion** (as parents decide), usually on the first Sunday of the month.

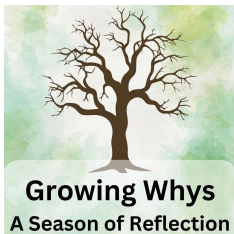

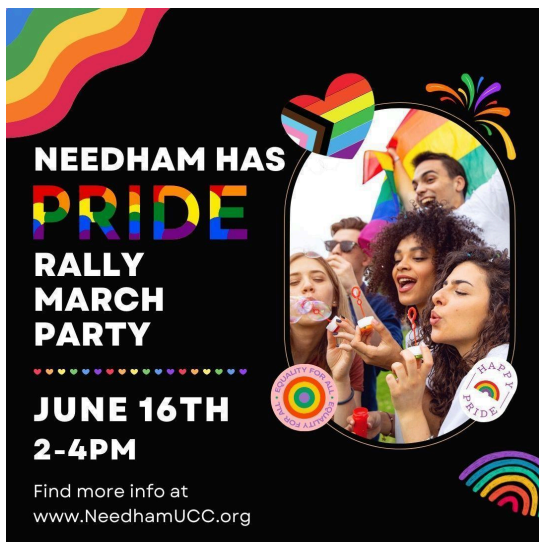

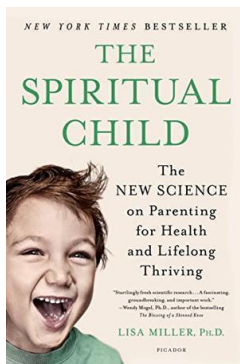


NEEDHAM HAS PRIDE: Join us for a "family-sized" RALLY! MARCH! & PARTY!

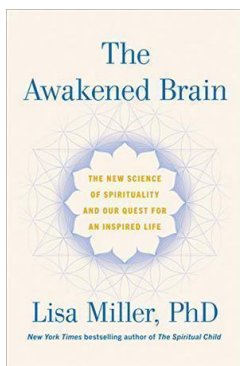
Summer Reading Groups: The Spiritual Child & The Awakened Brain

You're invited to join the Christian Education committee and our friends at Wellesley Hills Congregational Church in two reads this summer. *The Spiritual Child* will be offered to parents of young children, while *The Awakened Brain* is offered to folks across the lifespan. Both groups will have the opportunity to meet via Zoom to chat about what you've uncovered in your reading.

Parents reading *The Spiritual Child* will meet on the second Tuesdays at 7pm (June 11, July 9, August 13) and folks reading *The Awakened Brain* will meet with Rev. Maddie on the third Tuesdays at 7pm (June 18, July 16, August 20). Dr. Miller will join us in Wellesley (and on Zoom) in September to discuss her work.






